50th Kingston Christmas Bird Count 2017-18

The Kingston, NS Christmas Bird Count, held December 23, 2017, was a success and enjoyable from many points of view. Exciting for me was that we had our best field coverage ever, with 29 observers in 13-14 parties. We had 59 feeder watchers at 34 feeders, down somewhat from recent years. The weather cooperated, the freezing rain holding off until late PM. We had 63 species, three more than the ten year average. The number of individuals was 13,550, just below the ten year average. Most abundant species were European Starling, American Crow, Canada Goose, Black-capped Chickadee, and American Goldfinch, much as expected, except for the Canada Goose, which was incredibly high. These and the other 37 "A-List" species (those seen on 90% or more of the last 10 counts) were all seen except the Evening Grosbeak - a major miss although it has been declining in recent years. Another A-lister, the Pine Siskin, was almost missed, with only one observed. Among less common species missed, Surf Scoter, Horned Grebe, Horned Lark, and Pine Grosbeak were ones that we have had 50% or more of the time in the past decade. Two species were seen in the count week but not on count day: Wood Duck and Roughlegged Hawk.

At the other end of the highlights, several species rare in our area in winter were observed. No species new for our cumulative list, but there were two 2nd records - the Peregrine Falcon (recently removed from the endangered list in NS), seen by Sydney & Nelson Penner in North Kingston, and a Dickcissel (first recorded in 2015), seen by the Colvilles in Melvern Square. There were also two 3rd records ever: Yellow-breasted Chat, found at Nictaux Falls by Claire Diggins and Britt Roscoe, and Fox Sparrow, seen at Victoria Vale by Richard Stern and Ron Blackert. Other highlights of uncommon species found were Razorbill, Great Blue Heron, Grey (Canada) Jay, and both crossbills.
